A. Initiations

Selection

PI TAU SIGMA members are invited to join on a basis of sound engineering ability, scholarship ($GPA \geq 3.25$), personality, and probable future success in their chosen field of Mechanical Engineering. Honorary members are selected on the basis of successful achievements in the profession of mechanical engineering. Practicing engineers and full, associate, or assistant professors of mechanical engineering are eligible.

Initiation Procedure

Initiates holding candles were led into a dimly lighted room. The Crest and Insignia of Pi Tau Sigma were displayed and illuminated so that all initiates could clearly view them. The initiates were assembled before the officers and the president called the initiation ceremony to order. The President and Vice President read the initiation rituals of the Pi Tau Sigma and the candidates responded accordingly.
